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**AN ACT** Relating to Sick Leave for Employees of Public Works Department  
of City of Lewiston.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. X, § 4-A, amended.** The first sentence of section 4-A of article X of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as enacted by chapter 140 of the private and special laws of 1957, is amended to read as follows :

'Employees of the department of public works shall be allowed to accumulate ~~one day~~ **1½ days** of sick leave ~~for every 30 days worked~~ **per month worked**, a total of ~~12~~ **18** days per year, accumulating to ~~50~~ **70** days.'
