STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Sick Leave for Employees of Public Works Department of City of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. X, § 4-A, amended. The first sentence of section 4-A of article X of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as enacted by chapter 140 of the private and special laws of 1957, is amended to read as follows:

'Employees of the department of public works shall be allowed to accumulate one day I_{2} days of sick leave for every 30 days worked per month worked, a total of I_{2} 18 days per year, accumulating to 50 70 days.'
