STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Repealing Charter of Pittsfield Water Company and Transferring Assets to the Town of Pittsfield.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Assets, etc. to Town of Pittsfield. All real and personal property, together with all accounts receivable, choses in action, and all other rights and benefits that may be either due or payable to, or would accrue to, or for the benefit of the Pittsfield Water Company shall be and become the property of the Town of Pittsfield; said town being vested with all rights and powers of holding, disposing of or enforcing such rights so acquired.
- Sec. 2. Eminent domain. The Town of Pittsfield is authorized to exercise the powers of eminent domain as set forth in the Revised Statutes of 1954, chapter 90-B, section 6, for all purposes relating to public water supply.
- Sec. 3. P. & S. L., 1891, c. 230, repealed. Chapter 230 of the private and special laws of 1891 is repealed.
