STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Authorizing Treasurer of State to Convey Certain Island in Penobscot County.

Treasurer of State authorized to convey certain land. Resolved: That the Treasurer of State is authorized and directed to convey to Hollis J. Mallett, of Lincoln, interest of the State in the following described island:

A certain island known as Birch Island situated in Upper Cold Stream Pond near the boundary line between the Town of Lincoln and the Town of Enfield, County of Penobscot, State of Maine, being approximately Four Hundred Forty-Three (443) feet from Roberts Point, so called, and also Five Hundred Eighty-Four (584) feet from another point of land extending into Upper Cold Stream Pond now owned by Arthur Millett.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Birch Island is located in the north end of Cold Stream Lake. At high water only about 50 square feet of dry land is available. There is a cottage on the island.
