### STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Certain County Officials of Franklin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 89, § 254, amended. The 5th paragraph of section 254 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 7 of chapter 372 of the public laws of 1959 and as amended, which relates to Franklin County, is further amended to read as follows:

**'Franklin County:** County commissioners, \$900; clerk of courts, \$3,400 **\$3,700**; county attorney, \$3,000; county treasurer, \$1,200; sheriff, \$3,700 **\$4,000**; register of deeds, \$3,300 until January  $\pm$ , 1962 and \$3,800 **\$4,100** thereafter; judge of probate, \$2,000; register of probate, \$3,300 **\$3,600**; Franklin municipal court judge, \$3,000.'

Sec. 2. Effective date. This act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1963.
