STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Operation of Farm Trailers Without Registration.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 13, amended. Section 13 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding after the 9th paragraph the following new paragraph :

'No registration shall be required of a farm trailer when the same is used solely for farming purposes, and such farm trailer may be operated, without registration, from or to the premises where the same are kept, to or from a farm lot and between farm lots, used for farm purposes by the owner of the farm trailer. Such farm trailers may be operated without registration to a filling station or garage for gas, oil or repairs.'
