**AN ACT Repealing Laws Permitting and Prohibiting Certain Business on
Sunday and Holidays.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 134, §§ 38, 38-A, 38-B, repealed. Section 38 of chapter 134 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 1 of chapter 362 of the public laws of 1961, section 38-A of chapter 134 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 362 of the public laws of 1961 and section 38-B of chapter 134 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 302 of the public laws of 1959 and as amended by section 3 of chapter 362 of the public laws of 1961, are repealed.
