STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Extending Time on Attachments of Real Estate.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 112, § 72, amended. Section 72 of chapter 112 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding after the 2nd sentence a new sentence to read as follows:

'In the case of attachments of real estate, the aforesaid 60 day period may be extended for a definite or indefinite period, with the attachment remaining in full force and effect, by an order signed by any judge or justice of the court having jurisdiction over the cause of action upon which the attachment is based, provided said order is signed and recorded in the office of the register of deeds in the county or district where the said real estate or some part of it is situated within the said 60 day period.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 112, § 72, amended. The last sentence of section 72 of chapter 112 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The register shall be entitled to the same fee for bringing forward such attachment upon the said book of attachments as for the original entry thereof, and shall be entitled to a fee of \$2 for recording an order extending an attachment.'
