COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 636, L.D. 892, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Courses of Study at and Degrees by the State
Teachers' Colleges."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "Sec. 225." of
section 3 by striking out all of the underlined 5th, 6th and
7th lines and inserting in place thereof the following:

"the same. The board may confer appropriate degrees
based upon 4 or 5 years of instruction. Degrees beyond
the bachelor's degree may be granted only by colleges
accredited by the New England Association of Colleges
and Secondary Schools."
