AN ACT Relating to Fees of Arresting Officers for Warrants.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 15, § 2, amended. The 4th sentence of section 2 of chapter 15 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

‘As arresting officers, or aids, or witnesses in any criminal case, they shall be entitled to the same fees as any sheriff or deputy, **provided that only one such fee as arresting officer shall be paid for warrants arising out of the same transaction or occurrence.**’
