## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Eligibility of Trustees, Executors and Administrators as Directors of Trust Companies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 59, § 109, amended. Section 109 of chapter 59 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 109. Qualification of director. No person shall be eligible to the position of a director of any trust company who is not the unless he is actual owner of stock, or is a trustee, executor or administrator holding stock in such capacity amounting to \$1,000 par value, free from encumbrance encumbrances.'
