COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 665, L. D. 921, Bill,
"An Act Revising Certain Fire Laws."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated "Sec. 29-A." of section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following underlined section:

"Sec. 29-A. Authority. State Electrical inspectors shall have the right during reasonable hours to enter any building or premises in the discharge of their official duties or for the purpose of making any inspection, re-inspection or test of the electrical equipment contained therein or its installation. When any electrical equipment is found by a duly authorized state electrical inspector to be dangerous to persons or property because it is defective or improperly installed, the person, firm or corporation responsible for the electrical equipment or its installation shall, by the Insurance Commissioner, be notified in writing, and shall thereupon make any changes or repairs required to place such equipment in a safe condition."
