# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT to Permit Straight Voting on Liquor Local Option Questions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding before the 7th paragraph from the end the following:

"The following instructions must be printed in bold type above the appropriate squares printed at the right of each question: Above those squares designated "Yes," "TO VOTE YES ON ALL QUESTIONS MARK A CROSS (X) OR A CHECK MARK ( $\checkmark$ ) WITHIN THIS SQUARE." Above those squares designated "No," "TO VOTE NO ON ALL QUESTIONS MARK A CROSS (X) OR A CHECK MARK ( $\checkmark$ ) WITHIN THIS SQUARE."

Two squares having one-inch sides must be printed below the instructions, in which a voter may place a cross or a check mark to vote "yes" or "no" on all questions.'
