HOUSE AMENDMENT " A" to H.P. 669, L.D. 925, Bill, "An Act  
Relating to Resident Requirements for Malt Liquor  
Wholesale License."

Amend said Bill by striking out the underlined last 2  
lines and inserting in place thereof the following underlined  
sentence:

"Any wholesaler, if a person, shall have been a resident  
of this State for 6 months or, if a corporation, shall  
have conducted business in this State for 6 months  
before a license may be issued.' "
