**AN ACT Permitting Certain Liquor Licensees Providing Entertainment to
Charge Admission.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 40, amended. Section 40 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new paragraph to read as follows:

'Restaurants or hotels licensed under this section and furnishing live entertainment may establish admission charges.'
