HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 673, L.D. 929, Bill, "An Act
Permitting Sale of Liquor by Passenger Boat Corporations."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause, the following section:

"Sec. 1. R.S., c. 61, §1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding, in alphabetical order, the following paragraph:

"Passenger boat" shall mean a boat documented by the
United States Customs in the coasting trade and licensed by
the United States Coast Guard to carry 50 or more passengers."

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 1 to 5 to be sections 2 to 6.
