STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Rules and Regulations for Length of Duty of Drivers of Vehicles for Hire.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 48, § 26, repealed. Section 26 of chapter 48 of the Revised Statutes is repealed.
- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 48, § 27, amended. Section 27 of chapter 48 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by inserting after the first sentence 2 new sentences to read as follows:

'Such authority shall include the right to make rules and regulations relating to the length of duty of drivers operating any motor vehicle for the transportation of freight for hire on the highways of this State. Nothing in this section shall apply to common or contract carriers operating motor vehicles for the transportation of freight or merchandise for hire on the highways of this state if said carriers are required to comply with the length of duty of drivers regulations of the Interstate Commerce Commission.'
