STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Application of Federal Social Security to Permit Political Subdivisions to Offer Social Security Benefits to Superintendents of Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 65, § 1, amended. The next to the last sentence of section 1 of chapter 65 of the Revised Statutes, as last repealed and replaced by section 65 of chapter 429 of the public laws of 1957, is amended to read as follows:

'The provisions of this This chapter shall also apply to employees of Maine Maritime Academy and superintendents of schools who are members of an existing retirement or pension system.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 65, § 1, amended. The last sentence of section 1 of chapter 65 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by chapter 38 of the public laws of 1961, is further amended to read as follows:

'This chapter shall not apply to teachers and firemen who are under a state or local government pension or retirement plan, except teachers at the Maine Maritime Academy and superintendents of schools.'
