STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Closed Season for Scallops.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37-A, § 58, amended. The first paragraph of section 58 of chapter 37-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 331 of the public laws of 1959, is amended to read as follows:

'It is unlawful for any person to fish for or take scallops from the coastal waters of the State from the first 15th day of April until the 31st day of the following October of each year, except as provided in this section:'
