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**AN ACT Relating to Closed Season for Scallops.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**R. S., c. 37-A, § 58, amended.** The first paragraph of section 58 of chapter 37-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 331 of the public laws of 1959, is amended to read as follows :

'It is unlawful for any person to fish for or take scallops from the coastal waters of the State from the ~~first~~ 15th day of April until the 31st day of the following October of each year, except as provided in this section.'
