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**AN ACT Providing an Additional Reporter for Industrial Accident Commission.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., c. 31, § 29, amended.** The 4th paragraph of section 29 of chapter 31 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

‘The commission shall appoint a clerk and ~~a reporter~~ **full-time or part-time reporters** and such clerical assistance as may be receiving, subject to ~~the provisions of~~ the Personnel Law.’

**Sec. 2. Appropriation.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Industrial Accident Commission to carry out the purposes of this act the sum of \$7,098 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964 and the sum of \$7,475.50 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1965; the breakdown of which shall be as follows:
