STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Exempting Sales of Malt Liquor from the Sales Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 17, § 10, sub-§ XI-A, additional. Section 10 of chapter 17 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection XI-A, to read as follows:

'XI-A. Malt liquor. Sale of malt liquor subject to other taxes imposed by chapter 61.'

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The estimated loss of revenue would be approximately \$700,000 to \$750,000.
