AN ACT Increasing Salary of County Attorney of Sagadahoc County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 89, § 254, amended. That part of the 13th paragraph of section 254 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 7 of chapter 372 of the public laws of 1959 and as amended by section 1 of chapter 390 of the public laws of 1961, which relates to the salary of the county attorney of Sagadahoc County, is further amended to read as follows: 'county attorney, ~~\$3,000~~ \$5,200;'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of the Attorney General the sum of \$1,700 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964 and the sum of \$2,200 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1965 to provide for the increase in salary of county attorney of Sagadahoc County as set forth in section 1. The breakdown shall be as follows:
