## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officials of Knox County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 89, § 254, amended. The 8th paragraph of section 254 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 7 of chapter 372 of the public laws of 1959 and amended by section 1 of chapter 390 of the public laws of 1961, which relates to Knox County, is further amended to read as follows:

'Knox County: County commissioners, \$1,000 \$1,100; clerk of courts, \$3,800 \$4,000; county attorney, \$3,000; county treasurer, \$1,000 \$1,400; sheriff, \$4,000 \$4,400; register of deeds, \$3,700 \$4,000; judge of probate, \$2,700 \$3,000; register of probate, \$3,000; Knox County municipal court judge, \$3,200; associate judge, \$2,000.'

Sec. 2. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1963.
