## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Attorney and Assistant County Attorney of Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 254, amended. That part of the 3rd paragraph of section 254 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as last repealed and replaced by section 176 of chapter 417 of the public laws of 1961, which relates to the salaries of county attorney and assistant county attorney is amended to read as follows:

'county attorney, \$4,000 \$7,500; assistant county attorney, \$3,000 \$4,500;'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Attorney General the sum of \$3,750 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964 and the sum of \$5,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1965 to provide for the increases in the salaries of the county attorney and assistant county attorney for Aroostook County. The breakdown shall be as follows:
