STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Judge and Recorder of Town of Lincoln Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 89, § 254, amended. That part of the 11th paragraph of section 254 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 7 of chapter 372 of the public laws of 1959, and as amended, which relates to the salaries of judge and recorder of the Town of Lincoln Municipal Court, Penobscot County, is amended to read as follows:

'Town of Lincoln municipal court judge, \$3,200 \$4,000; recorder, \$2,000 \$2,400;'

Sec. 2. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1963.
