## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Height of Motor Vehicles and Trailers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 94, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 94 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'No motor vehicle or trailer any structural part of which, permanent or temporary, is more than 12 13 feet 6 inches in height measured vertically from a plane and level surface of ground or pavement shall be operated upon any way or bridge; provided, however, that the. The load on any motor vehicle or trailer may extend 1 foot 6 inches above the maximum permissible structural height of such motor vehicle or trailer.'
