STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Services for the Blind.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 25, § 300, amended. The last paragraph of section 300 of the Revised Statutes is repealed as follows:

'The commissioner is authorized to establish within the department a division, to be known as the division of services for the blind, charged with the responsibility for carrying on the provisions of this section'
