AN ACT Relating to Definition of Potatoes and Shipper Under the Potato Tax Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 16, § 223, amended. The first sentence of the 3rd paragraph of section 223 of chapter 16 of the Revised Statutes which defines "potatoes," as amended by section 2 of chapter 219 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:

' "Potatoes" shall mean and include all potatoes of the grades as recommended by the Fruit and Vegetable Division, Agricultural Marketing Service, United States Department of Agriculture and such other grades as may from time to time be promulgated by the Department of Agriculture of the State of Maine, all potatoes sold for processing into food for human consumption, and all potatoes sold under any Federal Irish Potato Division program equal to or better than the quality requirements of U. S. No. 2 grade.'
