IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Regulating the Open Season on Fisher.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 113, sub-§ I, amended. The 6th paragraph of subsection I of section 113 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'There shall be an annual open season for the hunting and trapping of fisher during the months of November, December, January and February. The commissioner may extend, shorten or close such fisher season as he may deem necessary.'
