## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Exempting Firemen from Waiting Period Under Workmen's Compensation Act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 31, § 10, amended. Section 10 of chapter 31 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 10. Waiting period; when compensation payable. No compensation for incapacity to work shall be payable for the first 7 days of incapacity; provided, however, that in, except that firemen shall receive compensation from the date of incapacity. In case incapacity continues for more than 28 days, compensation shall be allowed from the date of incapacity.'
