IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Defining Subdivision of Land for Municipal Regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 90-A, § 61, sub-§ V, ¶ A, sub-¶ 1, amended. Subparagraph 1 of paragraph A of subsection V of section 61 of chapter 90-A of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by chapter 206 of the public laws of 1961, is amended to read as follows:

'1. Subdivision means the division into 3 2 or more lots in urban areas or 4 3 or more lots in rural areas, except this provision shall not apply to any divisions for agricultural uses, including associated sales, service, processing and storage other than residential, commercial or industrial uses.'
