IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Pecuniary Interest by Municipal Officials in Municipal Contracts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 90-A, § 56, sub-§ II, amended. Subsection II of section 56 of chapter 90-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 405 of the public laws of 1957, is amended to read as follows:

'II. Contracts. A contract, other than a contract obtained through proper bid procedures, made by a city during the term of a city official who has a direct or an indirect pecuniary interest in it is void.'
