IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Proof of Municipal Ordinances.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 90-A, § 5-A, additional. Chapter 90-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 405 of the public laws of 1957, is amended by adding a new section 5-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 5-A. Proof of municipal ordinances. The submission to any court or administrative tribunal of a municipal ordinance, bylaw, order or resolve of the legislative body or municipal officers of a municipality, when such ordinance, bylaw, order or resolve has been certified over the signature of the municipal clerk, shall be prima facie proof of the validity thereof and of the regularity of all matters relating to the passage or enactment of the ordinance, bylaw, order or resolve and to any revision or codification thereof.'
