**AN ACT Providing for Issuance of Warnings to Licensees for Liquor Violations.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 61, § 56, sub-§ I, amended.** Subsection I of section 56 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes, as last repealed and replaced by chapter 218 of the public laws of 1959, is amended by adding after the 6th sentence a new sentence to read as follows:

**'In lieu of a signed complaint the duly designated enforcement officer of said commission may issue warnings to licensees.'**
