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**AN ACT Relating to Claims of Municipalities Against State for Taxes Lost  
From Veterans Property Tax Exemptions.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., c. 91-A, § 10, sub-§ III, ¶ H, amended.** Paragraph H of subsection III of section 10 of chapter 91-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 399 of the public laws of 1955, is amended to read as follows:

'**H.** Any municipality granting exemptions under ~~the provisions of~~ this subsection shall have a valid claim against the State to recover ~~70%~~ 90% of the taxes lost by reason of such exemptions as exceeds 3% of the total local tax levy, upon proof of the facts in form satisfactory to the Commissioner of Finance and Administration; ~~and such.~~ **Such** claims shall be presented to the Legislature next convening.'

**Sec. 2. Effective date.** This act shall become effective for the taxes lost in 1963 by reason of exemption of veterans.
