AN ACT Permitting County Funds for Buildings for Education Programs for Retarded Children.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 16-C, additional. Chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 16-C, to read as follows:

‘Sec. 16-C. Buildings for education of retarded children. A county may expend county funds to build buildings for educational programs for retarded children operated with approval of the State Department of Education and receiving state subsidies therefor.’
