IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Registration of Motor Vehicles Required to be Registered in Another State by Maine Residents.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 13, amended. The first paragraph of section 13 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as last repealed and replaced by chapter 73 of the public laws of 1961, is amended to read as follows:

'Except as section 67 provides for reciprocity with other states, any resident of this State and any owner, as defined in section 1, shall register any vehicle to be operated or to remain on any way in this State, except that residents of this State who have been required to register a vehicle in another state may operate said vehicle in this State for a period not to exceed a total of 30 calender days in any one year.'
