## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 101st LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 346, L. D. 1011, Bill, "An Act Act to Revise Certain Motor Vehicle Laws."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 9 and inserting in place thereof the following:

"Sec. 9. R. S., c. 22, §41, amended. Section 41 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statuces, as amended, is further amended by adding after the 2nd sentence, the following new sentences to read as follows:

Every singly driven motor vehicle and every combination of motor vehicles shall be equipped with parking brakes adequate to hold the vehicle or combination on any grade on which it is operated, under any condition of loading, on a surface free from snow or ice. The parking brakes shall be capable of being applied in conformance with these requirements by the driver's mascular effort or by spring action. Their operation may be assisted by the service brakes or other source of power provided that failure of the service brakes or other power assisting mechanism will not prevent the parking brakes from being applied in conformance with these requirements. The parking brakes shall be so designed that when once applied they shall remain in the applied position despite exhaustion of any source of energy or leakage of any kind."
