## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Relating to Capital Stock of Industrial Banks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 59, § 203, amended.** The first sentence of section 203 of chapter 59 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The capital stock of an industrial bank shall not be less than  $\frac{25,000}{50,000}$  in any town or city having a population of less than 50,000 inhabitants, and shall not be less than  $\frac{50,000}{50,000}$  in any town or city having 50,000 or more inhabitants and less than 150,000 inhabitants, and shall not be less than  $\frac{5100,000}{5200,000}$  in any town or city having 150,000 inhabitants or more, according to the last official census.'
