COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 354, L. D. 1020, Bill,  
"An Act Relating to Sale of Negotiable Checks  
and Money Orders."

Amend said Bill, in the 12th, 13th and 14th lines,  
by striking out the underlined words and punctuation  
"stating that his net worth is at least \$200,000. In lieu  
of the sworn statement as to his net worth, such person" ;  
and by striking out in the 21st line the underlined comma  
which appears after the underlined word "reputation"  
and inserting in place thereof the underlined word 'and' ;  
and by striking out in the 22nd line the underlined words  
"and net worth"
