IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Certain Advertising Signs Erected on the Interstate System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 23, § 147-A, sub-§ VI, amended. Subsection VI of section 147-A of chapter 23 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 3 of chapter 332 of the public laws of 1961, is amended to read as follows:
 - 'VI. Limitation. This section shall not affect any advertising sign or advertising structure which was in existence on or before May 26, 1961 on segments of the interstate system within the limits of an incorporated municipality which at the time of passage of this act or hereafter itself regulates or controls outdoor advertising by municipal ordinance.'
