SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 360, L. D. 1026, Bill, "An Act Providing  
for Area Directional Sign on Maine Turnpike for Rumford."

Amend said Bill in the Title by striking out the word "Sign"  
and inserting in place thereof the word 'Signs' and by inserting  
after the word "Rumford" the words 'and Washington County'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the  
first line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the fol-  
lowing section:

"Sec. 2. R. S., c. 23, §149-A, sub-§VIII-B, additional.

Section 149-A of chapter 23 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by  
chapter 419 of the public laws of 1957 and as amended, is further  
amended by adding a new subsection VIII-B, to read as follows:

'VIII-B. Washington County: Such sign shall be constructed  
and maintained on the Maine Turnpike no more than 10 miles  
southerly from the Augusta exit and shall be worded as follows:

Washington County - Land of the Sunrise, Lakes, Seashore  
and most Easterly Point in the United States - Exit 15;'"
