IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Providing for Area Directional Sign on Maine Turnpike for Rumford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 23, § 149-A, sub-§ III-A, additional. Section 149-A of chapter 23 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 419 of the public laws of 1957 and as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection III-A, to read as follows:

'III-A. Rumford Area: Such sign shall be constructed and maintained on the Maine Turnpike no more than 2 miles southerly from the Auburn exit and shall be worded as follows:

Rumford-Recreation and Ski Areas-Auburn Exit;'
