**AN ACT Relating to Open Season for Fishing During Month of October in
Washington County.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 44, sub-§ VII, additional. Section 44 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding a new subsection VII to read as follows:

'VII. Fishing in October in Washington County. The waters of Washington County shall be open to the taking of any species of fish except trout, salmon or togue during the month of October.'
