STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Requiring Approval of County Commissioners of Court Term Bills.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 131, amended. Section 131 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 131. Treasurer to account; may enforce payment of taxes. The treasurer shall keep his books and accounts on such form and in such manner as shall be approved by the State Department of Audit and shall apply all moneys received by him for the use of the county toward defraying its expenses, as the county commissioners and the Supreme Judicial or Superior Court by their written order direct; each. Each treasurer shall account with the commissioners of his county for all receipts and payments. He may enforce payment of taxes in the manner prescribed for the Treasurer of State.'
