AN ACT Providing for "Breath-Test-Meters."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 22, § 150-A, additional. Chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 150-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 150-A. Breath-test-meters. The State Police shall place at suitable locations throughout the State breath-test-meters for use by state, county and municipal police as an aid to determine the percentage by weight of alcohol in the blood at the time it is alleged the operator of a motor vehicle was operating or attempting to operate a motor vehicle upon any way or in any other place when intoxicated or at all under the influence of intoxicating liquor.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the State Police the sum of \$25,000 for the purchase of breath-test-meters to carry out the purposes of this act.
