**AN ACT Relating to Reimbursement of Towns for Medical Expenses of
Indigent Persons.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 94, § 11, amended. Section 11 of chapter 94 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 15 of chapter 405 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read as follows:

'Municipalities which expend moneys for medical care for the indigent persons under this section may be reimbursed therefor by the State Department of Health and Welfare, said reimbursement to be on a pro rata basis as determined by the department, except that the said department shall not reimburse any municipality for medical care which is provided while such indigent persons so relieved are confined to municipal institutions.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Welfare the sum of \$150,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964 and the sum of \$150,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1965 to carry out the purposes of this act.
