## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Providing for Working Capital for Bureau of Purchases.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 15-A, § 35-A, additional. Chapter 15-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 340 of the public laws of 1957, is amended by adding a new section 35-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 35-A. Working capital. The State Purchasing Agent is authorized to keep and have on hand a stock of materials and supplies for purchase by state departments, institutions and agencies. To provide such a stock a maximum permanent working capital is established at \$100,000. Permanent advances up to this amount may be authorized by the Governor and Council upon recommendation of the Commissioner of Finance and Administration.'
