AN ACT to Reduce the Cost of Renewal Fees for Cinematograph Operators' Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 100, § 74, amended. Section 74 of chapter 100 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 5 of chapter 182 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended by inserting after the 2nd sentence, a new sentence, as follows:

'All licenses issued as aforesaid shall expire one year from date of issue and they may be renewed thereafter for periods of one year without further examination on payment of a fee of \$2, commencing January 1, 1964.'
